The Rector is Fr. Nicholas Young, a native Canadian, who completed his theological training at Saint Tikhon's Seminary in South Canaan, PA.

All Saints of North America Orthodox Community was born in 2001 as an informal meeting of several English-speaking Orthodox faithful who assembled for regular Vespers and Typica services with the blessing of His Grace Bishop Seraphim of Ottawa. The community has fluctuated in size over its short life, and has been blessed to receive several new converts to Orthodoxy in the last year. Since May 2003, with the ordination of Father Geoffrey Korz to the priesthood, we have enjoyed regular Liturgies. From September 2003 to December 2005, we moved for Sunday morning Liturgy into the lower level of the St. Stephen's Anglican hall.

In January of 2006, the parish moved to its current home above a dental office at 117 Queenston Road in Hamilton. This new church location allows easy access from the local highways, as well as permanent, roomy facilities for services, luncheons, and the Desert Wisdom Bookroom, an Orthodox book and supply shop run by the parish.

Every year our community hosts the Chinese Missions Fundraising Dinner. We present information pertaining to the history of the Orthodox Christian mission in China, together with insights into the present events within the Chinese Orthodox Church. Money is raised for Liturgical translations into Chinese.
